

APS Fun Run – Funds and goals update

Following our fantastic Colour Fun Run earlier this year, we'd like to share an update on the funds raised and how those funds are already benefiting our students and school.

Thanks to the incredible support of our students, families and wider school community, we raised an amazing **\$14,805**.

2026 P&C GOALS

Based on priorities identified by the school, the P&C has committed to supporting the following initiatives throughout 2026:

- Fund the Acadiance software subscriptions. **(Completed)**
- Support the purchase of literacy resources. **(In Progress)**
- Support the purchase of numeracy resources. **(In Progress)**
- Upgrade the pre-primary playground. **(In Progress)**
- Install permanent junior soccer goals on the oval to provide safer, more defined play areas for students during recess and lunch. **(Completed)**
- Fund new student trolley trays for classrooms. **(In Progress)**
- Fund the upgrade of sporting equipment, including new athletics carnival bunting. **(Completed)**
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Progress Update

We're pleased to share that several of these projects have already been completed or are well underway.

A new permanent soccer goal was installed at the end of Term 2, providing students with a safer and more structured space to enjoy soccer during breaks.

Work has also begun on the renewal of the pre-primary playground. The P&C has been working closely with our pre-primary teachers to create a warm, welcoming and engaging outdoor space for our youngest students. Improvements currently underway include replacing worn equipment, creating safer play areas and introducing a nature-based water play area. The outdated yellow boat has also been removed and will be replaced with a new, safer playground feature.

To support our school sporting events, the P&C has also purchased new athletics bunting for use throughout the year.

We're also progressing the purchase of new student trolley trays, which will be rolled out across all classrooms as they arrive.

None of these projects would be possible without the amazing support of our school community. Thank you to everyone who participated in the Colour Fun Run and helped make these improvements possible. Your support is making a real difference for our students.

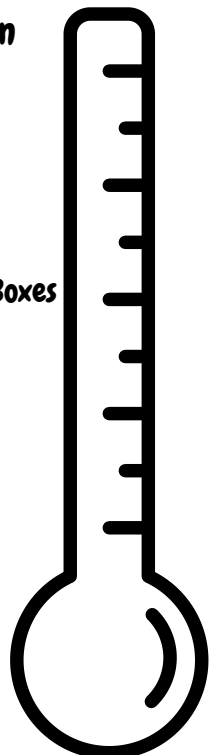
